- 10:15 Guided walking tour of the **Wayne County Historical Society Campus**, founded in 1904. This complex of 6 period furnished buildings & grounds includes a 1826 brick home, 1873 schoolhouse, 1880 county store & ladies' dress shop, firehouse & log house furnished ca. 1860. Another building houses the history of transportation including carriages, fire engines & a working model railroad. Other displays include early agricultural implements, blacksmith and woodworking tools, antique lamps & a large collection of birds & mammals.
- 12:00 Luncheon at The Olde Jaol Restaurant Dine in an historic cell. Claiming to be the finest sheriff facility of its kind, the Olde Jaol facility was built in 1865. In 1977 the jail closed & in 1980 was registered as a historical landmark. The Olde Joal Restaurant opened in 1995.
- 1:30 **Quailcrest Farm** One of the best known & respected herb farms in Ohio & surrounding states. Walk a self-guided tour of 25 display gardens. Quailcrest farm has an extensive variety of herbs, perennials, old roses, flowering shrubs, scented geraniums and more under a 12,000 sq. ft. greenhouse solarium. Watch a demonstration making a minature garden tray. A restored barn has many unique garden & home gifts.

- 3:30 Hartzler's Ice Cream Shop Old-fashioned premium ice cream & frozen custards (over 25 flavors) & cream-top milk in glass bottles all produced on premises. Choose a cone, sundae or parfait snack. Ice cream snacks not included in registration fee.
- 4:15 Garden of Roses of Legend & Romance & Secrest Arboretum, located on the campus of The Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center. Take a narrated wagon ride around 115-acre arboretum viewing more than 2,000 species & varieties of ornamental plants & trees, stopping to see & smell some of the 500 varieties of roses.
