He urged everyone to come up with ideas that would make the conference a success. Myron reminded the planners to work on gaining tax exempt status from South Dakota for the conference.

Deb needs a photo and bio from new board members for the website. She and Dave will send out dunning letters to past members who attended the conference within the last two years.

Josh pointed out that the CHS scholarship notices and applications need to be made available earlier.

Wayne discussed the idea of having our conference sponsors pay for any national speakers that might be brought in. Fees and expenses for national speakers can be a major expense and this might be an opportunity to bring on a new sponsor or give an existing sponsor an opportunity to support us in a more specific manner.
